True to its North Hollywood location, this 7-acre boutique property embodies a cool retro atmosphere that will transport you back to the glamour of 1970s L.A. Though the hotel completed a \$20 million makeover in 2015, it didn't abandon its past: Rooms are a nod to the hotel's '70s roots with bright orange accents and vintage-inspired furniture, but they're also equipped with more modern amenities like flat-screen TVs, free Wi-Fi access and minibridges. When you're not relaxing in your room, take time to explore the rest of the property. The hotel offers complimentary activities for guests like its "Dive-In Movie Night," where a film is screened poolside, plus a gift shop featuring locally sourced and California-inspired items (think California wines and specialty cookbooks). Even though you're within walking distance to a bevy of eateries, you'll want to stick around for at least one cocktail at the trendy Lobby Bar and a bite at The Front Yard, the hotel's on-site restaurant. When you want to explore off-property, The Garland's got you covered there, too: The hotel offers complimentary trolley service to Universal Studios and CityWalk, which made it a standout among its L.A. peers according to recent guests. Travelers also loved the laid-back ambiance of the property, with many saying it was an ideal hideaway thanks to the comfortable rooms, unique public spaces and exceptional service.
