Dogs get the Hollywood treatment at The Garland, a boutique property in North Hollywood that only charges \$75 per dog (40 pounds and under) per week. All dogs get a complimentary welcome toy, dog mat and doggy bowl with bottled water for their lapping pleasure. And you can upgrade your pet to receive a special box with a bandana and bespoke treat made by the property's executive chef. The hotel has a special dog-friendly area on-site where pooches can roam. And the concierge can point to off-leash places to head off on a hike together, like Fryman Canyon and Runyon Canyon.
